

- The PDMP Report link performs an “API call” to the New Mexico Prescription Monitoring Program (PMP) to retrieve the patient’s NARX report.
- It retains your user information, as well as the patient identifiers, so you don’t have to log in and search another site.



Some features are only available at the NM Board of Pharmacy’s website, e.g., to search for prescriptions made against your own DEA#; however, the most frequently accessed documents are available through the SYNCONYS HIE clinical portal.

The PDMP Report link performs an “API call” to the New Mexico Prescription Monitoring Program (PMP) to retrieve the patient’s NARX report. It retains your user information, as well as the patient identifiers, so you will be credited with having checked this patient.


