



# Rural Health Transformation

## **SYNCRONYS WORKS TO:**

- Consolidate health data sources
- Reduce waste of duplicative procedures
- Enable shared services to improve care coordination and patient outcomes,

- Enhance cost-efficiency across state agencies and healthcare providers
- Empower health professionals and patients with actionable insights

**SYNCRONYS' technology, interoperability, quality improvement and care coordination fall under several allowable state uses of Rural Health Transformation (RHT) Funding, and aligns with the development of a Health Data Utility (HDU) in New Mexico.**

# Rural Health Transformation

## SUGGESTED USE CASES TO NM MEDICAID

- **Enhancing the clinical data repository** by funding the cost charged by the electronic health record (EHR) vendors for 14 rural hospitals, 21 rural clinics and 10 FQHCs
- **Providing the annual subscription** of Core Solutions for 22 rural hospitals and 3,540 rural Medicaid Providers over the 5 years of the Rural Healthcare
- **Patient Portal:** Single access point for patients, aligning with CMS Interoperability Framework, using CMS digital identity credentials
- **SDOH Data Exchange and Interoperability** across CLRS Platforms
- **State Rural Health Dashboard:** Upgrade to health equity map
- **Smart Identity AI** to proactively identify individuals with undiagnosed conditions
- **Providing a backup** for health systems and hospitals continuity of operations due to Cyberattacks or natural disasters
- **Connecting Emergency Service Transports –** ImageTrend
- **Implementing Digital Adoption Professionals** transformation team
- **Bed Registry dashboard**
- **Advanced Directives Registry**
- **Supporting statewide master person index**
- **Medicaid work requirements reporting**

During a White House “Make Health Tech Great Again” event hosted with the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS), the Administration secured commitments from major healthcare and information technology firms –

# CMS Health Technology Ecosystem

Vision built on collaboration, not compliance. Calling on the healthcare industry – data networks, EHR systems, app developers and providers to align around a shared framework for data and access to empower people, improves care and accelerates progress.

HEALTH TECH ECOSYSTEM CATEGORIES	OBJECTIVE(S)
<b>CMS ALIGNED NETWORK</b>	Allow different types of health data sources, including health information networks and exchanges and other health technology platforms to align with CMS goals for interoperability
<b>EHR &amp; PROVIDER</b>	Ensure that providers and EHRs actively participate in CMS Aligned Networks by making complete, timely patient data available — not just structured data, but real-world clinical documentation and encounter signals that improve care coordination.
<b>PAYERS</b>	Join or create a CMS Aligned Network and provide claims data to CMS Aligned networks when requested by patients, providers, and, when appropriate, other payers.
<b>PATIENT FACING APPS</b>	Unlock the full potential of modern digital health, CMS is supporting a voluntary, standards-based ecosystem of private-sector technology partners - including apps, EHRs, and providers - that integrate with CMS Aligned Networks. This ecosystem is designed to deliver immediate value to patients through real-world, high-impact tools that are secure, user-centered, and connected. CMS is looking for early adopters to highlight and prove that modern technology is possible to deliver quickly.

# CMS-Aligned Network

SYNCRONYS has made a request to be a **CMS-Aligned Network**.

## **CMS-Aligned Networks:**

- Implement CMS Interoperability Framework criteria, including clinical and claims data as appropriate.
- Respond to patient, provider, and when appropriate, payer requests following the CMS Interoperability Framework.

Networks that meet the CMS Interoperability Framework will be designated as CMS Aligned Networks. Networks will self-attest to meet the interoperability criteria and agree to be reviewed if suspected to not be meeting the criteria.


